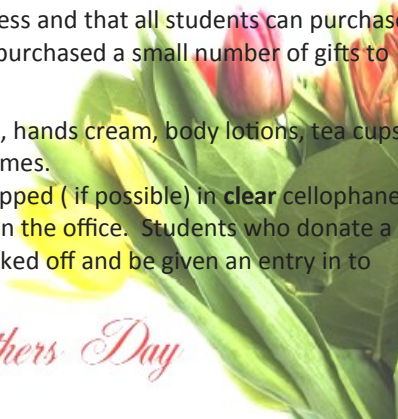
Mother's Day Stall
